## 07 Looking ahead 2023

**Programming, exhibitions & outreach:** Expand the film program, offer children and youth targeted programs, peer groups for artists, work with Visual Art NS to host their residency program in the Fall, connect with diverse communities through consultations, exhibitions, talks and presentations and collaborations, create a digital archive for YouTube channel. Connect with other schools in the region, find out how we can work together. Research possibilities of creating educational resources tied to exhibits/programs.

**Human Resources:** Apply to funding streams to engage up to two summer students (one project specific, one admin/paint the town specific), update HR and provide an onboarding pack for paid staff and volunteers, engage current membership for volunteer positions, committees.

**Revenue Generation:** Expand rentals, increase workshops, identify donors, identify grant opportunities. **Marketing, communications and advocacy:** Invest in marketing, update the website, create quarterly rack cards to show depth of programming, build & nurture relationships with government and community, hold community consultations (including artists and stakeholders).

## **Operations, governance and infrastructure:**

Review By-Laws, review the needs of the building, in terms of maintenance and potential expansion (accessibility); work on capital campaign, identify corporate donors; re: feasibility for building expansion, review policies, engage a group of advisors, professional development for staff and Board.
